SENATE RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING MARCH 2-8, 2015, AS NATIONAL MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS AWARENESS WEEK IN THE STATE OF RHODE ISLAND

1	WHEREAS, Multiple Sclerosis (MS) is a neurological disease of the central nervous
2	system, affecting 2.3 million people worldwide; and
3	WHEREAS, The National Multiple Sclerosis Society - Greater New England Chapter
4	reports that in our state nearly 2,000 people are diagnosed with MS, and that the disease generally
5	strikes people in the prime of life, between ages 20 through 50, and causes unpredictable effects
6	in which the progression, severity and specific symptoms cannot be foreseen, and the cause and
7	cure for this often debilitating disease remain unknown; and
8	WHEREAS, The National Multiple Sclerosis Society - Greater New England Chapter
9	has been committed for more than 60 years to a world free of MS, heightening public knowledge
10	about and insight into the disease; and
11	WHEREAS, Since 1946, the National Multiple Sclerosis Society has been a driving force
12	of MS research, relentlessly pursuing prevention, treatment and a cure and has invested more than
13	\$868 million dollars in groundbreaking research; and
14	WHEREAS, Funds raised through the National Multiple Sclerosis Society fuel the efforts
15	of nearly 380 research projects globally, totaling \$50.2 million dollars annually at the best
16	medical centers, universities and other institutions throughout the United States and abroad.
17	Because of this, MS research has never been more hopeful than it is today; and
18	WHEREAS, Discovering the cause, finding a cure, and preventing future generations

from being diagnosed with MS is an important task that all Americans and Rhode Islanders

should support; now	, therefore be it
