RELATING TO FISH AND WILDLIFE - GENERAL PROVISIONS

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 20-1 of the General Laws entitled "General Provisions" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 **20-1-29. Trade in shark fins.** (a) For the purpose of this section:
 - (1) "Shark" means any species of the subclass Elasmobranchii; and
- 5 (2) "Shark fin" means the raw, dried or otherwise processed detached fin, or the raw,
- 6 dried or otherwise processed detached tail, of a shark
- 7 (b) Except as provided in this section, no person shall possess, sell, offer for sale, trade or
- 8 <u>distribute a shark fin.</u>

- 9 (c) A person who holds a license or permit to take or land sharks may separate a shark fin
- 10 from a lawfully landed shark during the ordinary course of preparing the body of the shark for
- 11 consumption, sale, trade or distribution; provided, however, that a shark fin so separated from the
- 12 shark shall be immediately destroyed unless used by the person for the purposes of taxidermy and
- 13 <u>subsequent display.</u>
- 14 (d) The director of the department of environmental management may issue a permit for
- 15 <u>the possession of a shark fin to a person conducting noncommercial, scientific research.</u>
- 16 (e) Any shark fin seized by the director of the department of environmental management
- 17 or the director's agents through the enforcement of this section shall be destroyed.
- 18 (f) Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of
- 19 not less than five hundred (\$500) dollars, nor more than one thousand (\$1,000) dollars, or by

- 1 imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days or by both such fine and imprisonment;
- 2 provided, however, that each shark fin possessed, sold, offered for sale, traded or distributed in
- 3 violation of this section shall constitute a separate offense. Provided further a violation of this
- 4 section by a person holding a commercial or recreational license or permit pursuant to this
- 5 chapter shall result in the suspension or revocation of such license or permit.
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2016.
