5	WHEREAS, Immigrants have provided the United States and Rhode Island with unique
6	social and cultural influences, fundamentally enriching the extraordinary character of each; and
7	WHEREAS, Immigrants have been tireless leaders not only in securing their own rights
8	and access to equal opportunity, but have also campaigned to create a fairer and more just society

10	WHEREAS, Despite these countless contributions, the role of immigrants in building and
11	enriching our nation has frequently been overlooked and undervalued throughout our history, and
12	continues to the present day; and
13	WHEREAS, Rhode Island, since its founding by Roger Williams, has always been a
14	place that believes in individual freedom and of the power of new immigrants to add much
15	needed energy and vitality to our state and nation; and
16	WHEREAS, Immigrants to Rhode Island currently speak more than 60 languages and
17	represent more than 60 countries. Rhode Island has immigrants from a diverse array of countries
18	including Ireland, Italy, Lithuania, Germany, China, Cambodia, Dominican Republic, Mexico,
19	Guatemala, Colombia and many others nations; now, therefore be it

hereby respectfully requests that Governor Gina Raimondo declares the Month of June to be
