5 WHEREAS, Caregivers in Rhode Island need adequate support, such as proper funding 6 and continuing education, in order to effectively care for children; now, therefore be it

hereby respectfully requests the Rhode Island Department of Human Services to develop a
proposal creating a system of tiered reimbursements for licensed child care centers and family
child care providers with higher rates being issued to programs recognized as "higher quality" by

RESOLVED, That this Senate respectfully requests that the proposal include specific programs to support quality improvement and advancement in the department's quality rating system as well as comprehensive workforce development programs to assist licensed child care providers to pursue high school equivalency diplomas, associate's degrees, bachelor's degrees, college credits in early child care and education, and any other program deemed necessary; and be it further
