Drive-through windows. -- Every establishment selling drinks or food by the use of drive-through windows shall install at the ordering station serving each such window, 6 7 equipment to be used to assist the deaf and hard-of-hearing in ordering, and shall train its personnel in the use of such equipment. 8 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
