It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 28-9.2-7 of the General Laws in Chapter 28-9.2 entitled "Municipal
- 2 Police Arbitration" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 **28-9.2-7. Unresolved issues submitted to arbitration. --** In the event that the bargaining
- 4 agent and the corporate authorities are unable, within thirty (30) days from and including the date
- 5 of their first meeting, to reach an agreement on a contract, any and all unresolved issues shall be
- 6 submitted to arbitration; provided, the parties may agree in writing to extend the thirty (30) day
- 7 period as they so desire.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
