It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Title 6 of the General Laws entitled "COMMERCIAL LAW - GENERAL 2 REGULATORY PROVISIONS" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following chapter: 3 CHAPTER 41.1 **NON-COMPETITION AGREEMENTS** 4 5 <u>6-41.1-1. Non-competition agreements -- Enforceability. - Non-competition</u> agreements are declared to be contrary to the public policy of the state, and shall not be enforced 6 7 by its courts unless the non-competition agreement is integral to, and part of the consideration for 8 the sale of the stock or assets of a business, or the dissolution of a partnership or the withdrawal 9 of a partner from a partnership. 10 <u>6-41.1-2. Trade secrets not affected.</u> – Nothing in this chapter shall be deemed to affect or supersede the provisions of chapter 41 of title 6, the "Uniform Trade Secrets Act." 11

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
