It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 36-10 of the General Laws entitled "Retirement System-
- 2 Contributions and Benefits" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 36-10-41. Moratorium medical insurance deductibles and co-payments. --
- 4 Commencing January 1, 2017 until December 31, 2022, no retired state employee entitled to
- 5 receive medical insurance as a result of their state employment shall be required to pay a
- 6 <u>deductible or co-payment for any covered medical expense.</u>
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

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This act would release retired state employees entitled to receive medical insurance from paying a deductible or co-payment for any covered medical expense, commencing on January 1, 2017 until December 31, 2022.
