5	WHEREAS, With numerous philanthropic donors, including the support of myriad
6	groups such as The Preservation Society of Newport County, the Newport Restoration
7	Foundation, The 1772 Foundation, The Acquidneck Land Trust, and Salve Regina University, as
8	well as professional and weekend gardeners throughout the City-by-the-Sea, 494,000 daffodils,
9	nearly "half a dillion" have thus far been planted in Newport; and
10	WHEREAS, After a frigid and snowy winter, the sight of these cheery, bright yellow
11	daffodils will be a heart-warming, life-affirming, and ultimately welcome sight for even the most
12	stalwart New Englander; now, therefore be it
