It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 12-28 of the General Laws entitled "Victim's Rights" is hereby

12-28-3.1. Right of victim's representatives to consult with the department of the

attorney general in motor vehicle matters resulting in death. -- In any case wherein a person

5 is a suspect in a crime involving a motor vehicle offense under title 31, death resulting, and a

decision has been made not to prosecute the operator of a motor vehicle involved, the attorney 6

7 general shall provide written notice to the victim's representatives advising them of their right to

8 meet with the attorney general or designee to discuss the reason or reasons for the decision not to

9 prosecute.
