1 WHEREAS, The Ponaganset Boys' Hockey Team had an outstanding regular season, 2 compiling a sterling 17-1 record and outscoring their opposition 106 to 18. The Chieftains 3 accomplished these feats despite being a young squad playing nine freshman and only having 4 four seniors. They are a hard-skating and hard-working team that always plays with pride, 5 passion, and determination and always exhibits the utmost sportsmanship on the ice; and
