16	(11) One police chief selected by the Rhode Island Police Chiefs Association;
17	(12) The chief justice of the Rhode Island supreme court;

(13) The presiding justice of the superior court;

1 (14) The chief judge of the district court; 2 (15) The executive director of the Rhode Island League of Cities and Towns; 3 (16) The director of health; 4 (17) The director of the division of fire safety; 5 (18) One university or college faculty member with a research background in criminal justice appointed by the governor; 6 7 (19) Four (4) citizens appointed by the governor; 8 (20) Three (3) representatives appointed by the governor from community service 9 organizations.
