It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 42-64.13 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Regulatory
- 2 Reform Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

42-64.13-11. Duty to streamline and coordinate interagency regulation for green

- 4 industries. The office of regulatory reform shall, in consultation with the departments of
- 5 environmental management, labor and training, revenue, and the coastal resources management
- 6 council, and plant-based and agriculture industry representatives, to reduce burdensome
- 7 regulations, improve interagency efficiency, and coordinate the regulatory process to facilitate
- 8 <u>further economic growth within plant-based industries and agriculture.</u>
 - SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
