RELATING TO MOTOR AND OTHER VEHICLES -- REGISTRATION OF VEHICLES

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

Date Introduced: January 27, 2016

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 31-3 of the General Laws entitled "Registration of Vehicles" is 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 31-3-104. Special plate for Rhode Island private colleges and universities. -- (a) The 4 administrator of the division of motor vehicles is empowered to make available special motor 5 vehicle registration plates for passenger vehicles based upon the various independent nonprofit institutions of higher education (Brown University, Bryant University, Johnson & Wales 6 7 University, New England Institute of Technology, Providence College, Rhode Island School of 8 Design, Roger Williams University, and/or Salve Regina University). 9 (b) The special plate(s) shall be displayed upon the same registration number assigned to 10 the vehicle for which it was issued and shall be used in place of and in the same manner as the registration plates issued to the vehicle. The original registration plates for the vehicle shall be 11 12 removed from the vehicle and returned to the division of motor vehicles. The registration 13 certificate for the plates shall be carried in the vehicle, in accordance with §31-3-9. The 14 registration certificate shall be in effect for the special plates. 15 (c) The respective independent higher education institution's motor vehicle plates shall be the same size as regular motor vehicle plates and shall be designed in conjunction with the 16 17 division of motor vehicles, with design approval by the Rhode Island state police. 18 (d) Each independent higher education institution plate shall be subject to a minimum

prepaid order of at least nine hundred (900) sets of plates per institution per plate type (i.e.

| 1 | passenger, commercial, etc.). The respective independent higher education institution plate shall |
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| 2 | not be issued unless the minimum order requirements are met by the requesting institution. The |
| 3 | initial order will be handled by the president of the Association of Independent Colleges and |
| 4 | Universities of Rhode Island (AICU RI), or their designee, and shall not be submitted to the |
| 5 | division of motor vehicles for production until the minimum order has been met and the proper |
| 6 | paperwork submitted to the division. The AICU RI president, or their designee, will act as |
| 7 | program coordinator and point of contact for the division of motor vehicles. Subsequent |
| 8 | independent higher education institution plate orders will be handled by the division of motor |
| 9 | vehicles. |
| 10 | (e) The administrator of the division of motor vehicles shall develop prepayment |
| 11 | procedures and any other procedures deemed necessary to carry out the purposes of this section. |
| 12 | (f) In addition to the regular prescribed motor vehicle registration fee, independent higher |
| 13 | education institution plates shall be subject to a forty dollar (\$40.00) issuance surcharge. |
| 14 | (g) The forty dollar (\$40.00) issuance surcharge shall be allocated as follows: twenty |
| 15 | dollars (\$20.00) shall be allocated to the general fund and the remaining twenty dollars (\$20.00) |
| 16 | shall be distributed annually to the respective independent higher education institution as a |
| 17 | nonprofit educational institution based in Rhode Island. |
| 18 | (h) A ten dollar (\$10.00) surcharge for subsequent registration renewals will go to the |
| 19 | respective independent higher education institution. |
| 20 | (i) There shall be no refunds for early cancellation of independent higher education |
| 21 | institution plates. |
| 22 | (j) Any respective independent higher education institution not pursuing or not reaching |
| 23 | the minimum prepaid order of plates, as outlined in subsection (d) of this section, within thirty-six |
| 24 | (36) months after this section is enacted will not be eligible to obtain special motor vehicle |
| 25 | registration plates as outlined above, absent further action of the general assembly. |
| 26 | SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. |
