It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 22-3-18 of the General Laws in Chapter 22-3 entitled "Organization
 of General Assembly" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>22-3-18. Electronic voting. --</u> For the purpose of receiving and recording the vote of 4 members of the general assembly pursuant to the rules of the senate and the house of 5 representatives, the joint committee on legislative services shall provide for the senate and house 6 of representatives an electronic device or devices for the use by the members of the general 7 assembly in casting and recording votes.
- 8 The Joint Committee on Legislative Services shall make the record of the vote available
- 9 to the public electronically not later than thirty (30) minutes following the casting of said vote,
- 10 and shall similarly provide the record of said vote electronically to the Secretary of State.
- 11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
