It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 9-1-45 of the General Laws in Chapter 9-1 entitled "Causes of
- 2 Action" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 9-1-45. Attorney's fees in breach of contract actions. -- The court may award a 3
- 4 reasonable attorney's fee to the prevailing party in any civil action arising from a breach of
- 5 contract in which the court:
- 6 (1) Finds that there was a complete absence of a justiciable issue of either law or fact
- 7 raised by the losing party; or
- 8 (2) Renders a default judgment against the losing party-; or
- 9 (3) Finds for the defendant.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. 10
