# AN ACT

#### RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES -- LONG-TERM MANAGED CARE ARRANGEMENTS

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 40-8.13-6 of the General Laws in Chapter 40-8.13 entitled "Long-
- 2 Term Managed Care Arrangements" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- <u>40-8.13-6. Payment incentives. --</u> In order to encourage quality improvement and promote appropriate utilization incentives for providers in a managed long-term care arrangement, a managed care organization may use incentive or bonus payment programs that are in addition to the rates identified in <u>§ 40-18.13-5</u> <u>§40-8.13-5</u>. In addition, managed care organizations shall work in consultation with the EOHHS to develop incentives for nursing facilities that demonstrate lower direct care staff turnover.
  - SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
