- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general law or public law to the contrary, the Cranston
- 2 City Council may, by ordinance or resolution, consider Colonel Michael Winquist to no longer be
- 3 a member of the Rhode Island Municipal Employees' Retirement System and therefore Colonel
- 4 Michael Winquist may participate as a member of the City of Cranston's 401(k) Retirement Plan.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
