It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 4-1 of the General Laws entitled "Cruelty to Animals" is hereby 2 amended by adding thereto the following section: 3 <u>4-1-43. Use of bullhooks or similar devices on elephants prohibited. – (a)</u> 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person who houses, possesses, or is in direct 5 contact with an elephant may not: (1) Use a bullhook, ankus, baseball bat, axe handle, pitchfork, or similar device designed 6 7 to inflict pain for the purpose of training or controlling the behavior of an elephant; or 8 (2) Permit an employee, agent, or contractor to use a bullhook, ankus, baseball bat, axe 9 handle, pitchfork, or similar device designed to inflict pain for the purpose of training or 10 controlling the behavior of an elephant. (b) Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be fined not more than 11 12 five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per violation, or imprisoned for not more than one year, or by both 13 such fine and imprisonment. 14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2017.
