He was also the very 5 proud grandfather of James David Carnevale; and 6 WHEREAS, Bernard Frezza, better known as "Bernie" to his family and many friends, 7 was born on June 9, 1952, and grew up in the Town of North Providence where he attended the public schools and built friendships that would last throughout his lifetime. He earned his 8 9 Bachelor's degree in Marketing Management and a certificate in Paralegal Studies from Roger 10 Williams University; and 11 WHEREAS, For many years, Bernie was employed and held myriad positions within the 12 Rhode Island Department of Transportation. In March of 2015, he was named Acting Director of 13 Legislative and Government Affairs for the Department, and as of May of 2016, he was named 14 Director. In addition, he had previously been the Public Information Director in the Office of the 15 Secretary of State under the Honorable James Langevin; and 16 WHEREAS, Gifted with an exceptional ability to converse with everyone and on a broad 17 spectrum of topics, Bernie particularly loved politics and the discussions that ensued. He was a member of Johnston Democratic Town Committee and had previously been a member of the 18

North Providence Democratic Town Committee, and was the Chairman of the Johnston Zoning

3	a Troop leader when his son was younger. In addition, he was a member of the Knights of

7	infinite value of people and had a way of interacting with those around him that made them know
