3	RELATING TO MINIMUM WAGES
4	SECTION 1. Section 28-12-3 of the General Laws in Chapter 28-12 entitled "Minimum
5	Wages" is hereby amended to read as follows:
6	28-12-3. Minimum wages.
7	(a) Every employer shall pay to each of his or her employees: commencing July 1, 1999
8	at least the minimum wage of five dollars and sixty-five cents (\$5.65) per hour. Commencing
9	September 1, 2000, the minimum wage is six dollars and fifteen cents (\$6.15) per hour.
10	(b) Commencing January 1, 2004, the minimum wage is six dollars and seventy-five cents
11	(\$6.75) per hour.
12	(c) Commencing March 1, 2006, the minimum wage is seven dollars and ten cents (\$7.10
13	per hour.
14	(d) Commencing January 1, 2007, the minimum wage is seven dollars and forty central
15	(\$7.40) per hour.
16	(e) Commencing January 1, 2013, the minimum wage is seven dollars and seventy-five
17	cents (\$7.75) per hour.
18	(f) Commencing January 1, 2014, the minimum wage is eight dollars (\$8.00) per hour.
19	(g) Commencing January 1, 2015, the minimum wage is nine dollars (\$9.00) per hour.
20	(h) Commencing January 1, 2016, the minimum wage is nine dollars and sixty cents (\$9.60)
21	per hour.
22	(i) Commencing October 1, 2017, the minimum wage is ten dollars and fifty cents (\$10.50
23	per hour.
24	SECTION 2. This article shall take effect upon passage.
