4 DRIVE-THROUGH WINDOWS -- ASSISTANCE TO DEAF AND HARD-OF-HEARING

- 5 21-27.2-1. Drive-through windows.
- 6 Every establishment selling drinks or food by the use of drive-through windows shall
- 7 install at the ordering station serving each such window, equipment to be used to assist the deaf
- 8 and hard-of-hearing in ordering, and shall train its personnel in the use of such equipment.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
