It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 12-28 of the General Laws entitled "Victim's Rights" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>12-28-3.1. Right of victim's representatives to consult with the department of the</u>

- 4 <u>attorney general in motor vehicle matters resulting in death.</u>
- 5 In any case wherein a person is a suspect in a crime involving a motor vehicle offense
- 6 under title 31, death resulting, and a decision has been made not to prosecute the operator of a
- 7 motor vehicle involved, the attorney general shall provide written notice to the victim's
- 8 representatives advising them of their right to meet with the attorney general or designee to
- 9 discuss the reason or reasons for the decision not to prosecute.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL PROCEDURE -- VICTIM'S RIGHTS

1 This act would provide that in cases where there is a motor vehicle accident with death 2 resulting, if the attorney general decides not to prosecute a criminal case, that the attorney general 3 shall give the decedent's representatives an opportunity to discuss why the matter is not being 4 prosecuted.
