9	indicated, all of our food products contain genetically modified organisms."
10	(b) The sign requirement as set forth in subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to
11	restaurants, take-out or fast-food establishments.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO FOOD AND DRUGS - GENETICALLY MODIFIED ORGANISMS

This act would require all businesses that sell food which have gross annual sales of over five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000), with the exception of restaurants, to post signs that inform their customers that all the food products that are offered for sale contain genetically modified organisms unless clearly indicated otherwise.

This act would take effect upon passage.
