It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 12-5 of the General Laws entitled "Search Warrants" is hereby

2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

12-5-11. Sealing of search warrant.

4 The clerk of any court receiving an application for the issuance of a search warrant shall

seal the application and all related records and orders until such time as charges are brought 5

against any individual or entity pursuant to or with respect to such warrant, unless the court 6

7 issuing the warrant issues an order granting an individual or entity relief from the seal upon good

cause shown, including an assertion that the record is necessary for the preparation of a defense 8

9 by a person or entity charged.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
