It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 36-6 of the General Laws entitled "Salaries and Traveling
- 2 Expenses" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>36-6-23. Paid leave for organ donors.</u>
- 4 An employee of the state of Rhode Island or any city or town in the state, may take a
- 5 leave of absence of not more than thirty (30) days in a calendar year to serve as an organ donor,
- 6 without loss of or reduction in pay and without loss of leave to which they are otherwise entitled.
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
