- 2 Committees and Superintendents [See Title 16 Chapter 97 The Rhode Island Board of
- 3 Education Act]" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 4 <u>16-2-10. Certification of superintendents.</u>
- 5 (a) No person shall be employed as superintendent of schools in any city or town unless
- 6 the person holds a certificate of qualification issued by or under the authority of the state board of
- 7 regents for council on elementary and secondary education.
- 8 (b) The fee for taking any assessment required to be licensed and certified as a
- 9 superintendent shall be waived for any candidate who possesses a doctorate degree.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
