It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 42-28 of the General Laws entitled "State Police" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 <u>42-28-2.1. Ranking of alternates for state police training academy.</u>
- 4 (a) The superintendent of the state police shall require that any applicant for the Rhode
- 5 Island state police training academy who is not selected for the class but placed on a list of
- 6 potential alternates for the class shall be ranked according to objective qualification standards.
- 7 (b) Any vacancy occurring during any class of the Rhode Island state police training
- 8 <u>academy shall be filled by the highest-ranking applicant on the list required by this section.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
