It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 5-53.1-12.1 of the General Laws in Chapter 5-53.1 entitled
"Solicitation by Charitable Organizations" is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-53.1-12.1. Solicitation -- Requirements.

- Prior to orally requesting a contribution, or contemporaneously with a written request for a contribution, <u>regardless of how the request is made</u>, the following shall be clearly and conspicuously disclosed:
- (a) The name of the professional solicitor and professional fund-raiser, the name of the entity that employed or otherwise engaged the professional solicitor or professional fund-raiser, and the fact that the solicitation is being conducted by a professional solicitor—: and
- (b) If requested by the prospective donor, the The percentage of the contribution to be retained by the professional fund-raiser or the company that employed or otherwise engaged the professional fund-raiser.
- (c) Any solicitation that is subject to this section, regardless of how the solicitation is
 made, shall include the following statement:
- "My name is [insert full name] and I am an employee of [insert name of fundraising company]. I am a paid representative soliciting charitable contributions on behalf of [insert name of charitable organization]. I am required by Rhode Island law to inform you that [insert name of fundraising company] receives no less than [insert percentage] percent of aggregate contributions

- 1 <u>in payment for its fundraising services."</u>
- 2 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
