It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of §16-2-27, the North Kingstown School

Committee may develop a policy to allow a child who has not attained five (5) years of age on or

before September 1 of any school year, to be eligible to attend kindergarten for all the days that

4 the kindergarten is in session during that school year. If a child is so enrolled in kindergarten

under this policy, the attendance requirements of §16-19-1 shall apply. Any policy must include

school-readiness criteria to be applied on an individual basis. Any policy must provide children

turning five (5) years of age after September 1 of the school year may be enrolled in kindergarten

that same school year only if they are determined to be school-ready on the basis of relevant,

established criteria.
