It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 28-9.7-7 of the General Laws in Chapter 28-9.7 entitled
- 2 "Correctional Officers Arbitration" is hereby amended to read as follows:

28-9.7-7. Unresolved issues submitted to arbitration.

In the event that the bargaining agent and the state authorities are unable within thirty

5 (30) days from and including the date of their first meeting to reach an agreement on a contract,

6 any and all unresolved issues shall be submitted to arbitration. The parties may agree in writing to

- 7 extend the thirty (30) day period.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

3 contract, before submitting unresolved issues to arbitration.
