It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Title 27 of the General Laws entitled "Insurance" is hereby amended by
2	adding the following chapter thereto:
3	CHAPTER 83
4	SNOW REMOVAL SERVICE LIABILITY LIMITATIONS ACT
5	<u>27-83-1. Short title.</u>
6	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Snow Removal Service Liability
7	Limitation Act."
8	27-83-2. Definitions.
9	When used in this chapter:
10	(1) "Service provider" means a person providing services under a snow removal and ice
11	control services contract.
12	(2) "Service receiver" means a person receiving services under a snow removal and ice
13	control services contract.
14	(3) "Snow removal and ice control services contract" means a contract or agreement for
15	the performance of any of the following:
16	(i) Plowing, shoveling, or other removal of snow or other mixed precipitation from a
17	service;
18	(ii) De-icing services; or

- 1 (iii) Service incidental to an activity described in subsection (3)(i) or 3(ii) of this section, 2 including operation or otherwise moving snow removal or de-icing equipment, or materials. 3 27-83-3. Certain indemnity agreements void. 4 A provision, clause, covenant, or agreement that is part of or in connection with a snow 5 removal and ice control services contract is against public policy and void if it does any of the 6 following: 7 (1) Requires, or has the effect of requiring, a service provider to indemnify a service 8 receiver for damages resulting from the acts or omissions of the service receiver or the service 9 receiver's agent or employees. 10 (2) Requires, or has the effect of requiring, a service receiver to indemnify a service 11 provider for damages resulting from the acts or omissions of the service provider or the service 12 provider's agents or employees. 13 (3) Requires, or has the effect of requiring, a service provider to hold a service receiver 14 harmless from any tort liability for damages resulting from the acts or omissions of the service 15 receiver or the service receiver's agents or employees. 16 (4) Requires, or has the effect of requiring, a service receiver to hold a service provider 17 harmless from any tort liability for damages resulting from the acts or omissions of the service 18 provider or the service provider's agents or employees. 19 (5) Requires, or has the effect of requiring, a service provider to defend a service receiver 20 against any tort liability for damages resulting from the acts or omissions of the service receiver 21 or the service receiver's agents or employees. 22 (6) Requires, or has the effect of requiring, a service receiver to defend a service provider 23 against any tort liability for damages resulting from the acts or omissions of the service provider 24 or the service provider's agents or employees. 25 27-83-4. Applicability. (1) This chapter applies to snow removal and ice control services contracts entered into 26 27 on and after the effective date of this chapter. 28 (2) This chapter does not apply to contracts for snow removal or ice control services on 29 public roads or with public bodies. 30 (3) This chapter does not apply to contracts for snow removal or ice control services with 31 a public utility. 32 (4) This chapter does not affect any liabilities, immunities, or affirmative defenses arising 33 under other law.
