He currently oversees fifty-three officers within the department; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Throughout his tenure in law enforcement, Chief Vespia has consistently demonstrated integrity and outstanding leadership skills and has amassed an inspiring record of 10 11 untarnished excellence and accomplishment. He has also earned numerous awards, citations, and 12 honors, and is a member of a plethora of professional organizations; and 13 WHEREAS, In addition to his many years in law enforcement, Chief Vespia is also the 14 husband of Judith-Ann, and together they are the parents of three daughters and the very proud 15 grandparents of four grandchildren; and WHEREAS, On November 1st of 2016, Chief Vespia retired having earned the 16 17 distinction of being the longest-serving Police Chief in the State of Rhode Island and attaining the 18 respect and admiration of his fellow "brothers in blue" and the citizens of South Kingstown and 19 the State of Rhode Island; now, therefore be it
