It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 2 Reform Act" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 42-64.13-12. Duty to streamline and coordinate interagency regulation for green
- 4 industries.
- 5 The office of regulatory reform shall, in consultation with the departments of
- 6 environmental management, labor and training, revenue, and the coastal resources management
- 7 council, and plant-based and agriculture industry representatives, to reduce burdensome
- 8 regulations, improve interagency efficiency, and coordinate the regulatory process to facilitate
- further economic growth within plant-based industries and agriculture. 9
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
