#### 42-64.13-12. Duty to streamline and coordinate interagency regulation for green

- 4 industries.
- 5 The office of regulatory reform shall, in consultation with the departments of
- 6 environmental management, labor and training, revenue, and the coastal resources management
- 7 council, and plant-based and agriculture industry representatives, reduce burdensome regulations,
- 8 improve interagency efficiency, and coordinate the regulatory process to facilitate further
- 9 <u>economic growth within plant-based industries and agriculture.</u>
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
