It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 28-12 of the General Laws entitled "Minimum Wages" is hereby
- 2 amended by adding thereto the following section:

3 <u>28-12-3.3. Minimum wages for employees of developmental disabilities</u>

- 4 organizations.
- 5 Commencing January 1, 2018, every covered employer providing services to five (5) or
- 6 more persons with developmental disabilities, that are reimbursed for such services by the state,
- 7 shall pay each of their employees, at least fifteen (\$15.00) dollars per hour. For the purposes of
- 8 this section, covered employers are those developmental disability organizations licensed to
- 9 provide services pursuant to §40.1-24-3.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

EXPLANATION

BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

OF

AN ACT

RELATING TO LABOR AND LABOR RELATIONS - MINIMUM WAGES

1 This act would, commencing on January 1, 2018, require that all developmental 2 disabilities organizations that employ five (5) employees or more and who are reimbursed for 3 such services by the state, to pay their employees at least fifteen (\$15.00) dollars per hour.

This act would take effect upon passage.
