It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 42-64 of the General Laws entitled "Rhode Island Commerce Corporation" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:

42-64-42. Combat veterans' small business loan program.
(a) The director of the Rhode Island commerce corporation shall develop a combat veterans' small business loan program.
(b) The combat veterans' small business loan program shall:
(1) Provide combat veterans with business plan assistance;
(2) Promote combat veterans small business loans;
(3) Provide small business loans not to exceed fifty thousand dollars ( $\$ 50,000$ ) per veteran and one million dollars ( $\$ 1,000,000$ ) in total per year; and
(4) Partner with the United States Small Business Administration and private lenders to leverage the funds available to combat veterans seeking to start a small business in Rhode Island.
(c) For the purposes of this section, a "combat veteran" means a veteran who has been awarded or who is eligible to be awarded their service medal or badge which indicates they participated in combat against an armed enemy.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
