WHEREAS, During FY17, the State of Rhode Island celebrated the 50th Anniversary of 1 2 Project Discovery by investing in the Grade 11 Project pilot at Trinity Rep; and 3 WHEREAS, At least 42 Rhode Island high schools have participated in the Grade 11 Project to take part in an open forum for students to gain a deeper understanding of the content 4 and context of plays and their production; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Project Discovery uses theater to teach students about empathy, conflict resolution, creativity and the human experience, while also providing reinforcement of core 7 curricular subjects, and research shows that the skills and attributes demanded by 21st century 8 employers are instilled through arts learning experiences; and 9 10 WHEREAS, With a grant of \$100,000 from the State of Rhode Island, matched by private fundraising, Rhode Island high school students will experience a free professional, fully 11 12 produced theatrical performance with wraparound learning support; now, therefore be it 13 RESOLVED, That there is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the treasury not 14 otherwise appropriated for the fiscal year 2017-2018, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars

(\$100,000) to the Trinity Repertory Company to implement the Project Discovery Program; and

the state controller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his orders upon the general treasurer

for the payment of said sum, upon receipt of properly authenticated vouchers.
