It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 36-4 of the General Laws entitled "Merit System" is hereby 2

amended by adding thereto the following section:

36-4-66. Electronic log in required.

All state employees in the non-supervisory classified services shall be required to 4

5 complete a daily electronic log-in and log-out time indicating the number of work hours for each

day worked. The method for electronically recording such hours shall be recorded using existing

computer resources and shall be administered by the department of administration. The director is 7

hereby directed to establish whatever rules and regulations shall be required to carry out the

9 purposes of this section.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
