They provide training and competitions for more than five million athletes from more than 170 countries; and 6 7 WHEREAS, In 2017, Amy competed for the United States at the Special Olympics World Winter Games in Austria against athletes from across the globe in the sport of alpine 8 9 skiing. She excelled on the worldwide stage, winning a Gold Medal thanks to her 1st place finish 10 in the Alpine Giant Slalom event. She also competed in the Alpine Intermediate Super G event 11 and earned a Ribbon for her 4th place finish; and 12 WHEREAS, Amy is a high school graduate who teaches first-grade religious education at 13 her church. She loves teaching and strives to help children to reach their full potential. She has recently accepted a position as a substitute at Countryside Preschool and credits her parents and 14 15 the Special Olympics for much of her success. Thanks to the Special Olympics, Amy found it 16 easier to become comfortable meeting new people, has made many new friends, and has become a much more confident person; now, therefore be it 17 18 RESOLVED, That this Senate of the State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations
