It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2-1-10 of the General Laws in Chapter 2-1 entitled "Agricultural

Functions of Department of Environmental Management" is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### **2-1-10.** Inspection powers.

- (a) For the purpose of conducting inspections, the director of environmental management
- 5 and the director of health, or any of his or her agents or deputies, have authority to enter, at any
- reasonable time, any building, storehouse, warehouse, cold-storage plant, packing house, 6
- 7 stockyard, railroad yard, railroad car, or any other building or place where farm products are
- produced, kept, stored, or offered for sale, or to enter upon any farm land for the purpose of 8
- 9 inspecting farm products.

- 10 (b) The director of the department of environmental management, in consultation with
- the director of the department of health, shall enforce the commercial growers of fruits and 11
- 12 vegetables voluntary food safety program developed by the Food and Drug Administration and
- 13 the United States Department of Agriculture known as Good Agricultural Practices (GAP), and
- 14 shall enforce the Food Safety Modernization Act as it pertains to commercial growers of fruits
- and vegetables. 15
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. 16
