It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-9-9 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-9 entitled "Children" is

hereby amended to read as follows:

### 11-9-9. Powers of family court.

Where in §§ 11-9-1 -- 11-9-8 any authority is vested in any court, the authority vested in

the court or courts mentioned is transferred to the family court. The family court shall have

6 exclusive original jurisdiction over any and all complaints and offenses set forth in §§ 11-9-1 --

7 11-9-8, 11-9-12, 11-9-14, and 11-9-15, and shall have the authority to impose sentence as set

forth in chapter 1 of title 14. Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, jurisdiction for

9 violations of §§ 11-9-1, 11-9-1.1, 11-9-1.2, 11-9-1.3, <u>11-9-1.5</u>, 11-9-5.3 shall be vested in the

10 superior court.
