- 3 <u>44-5-86. The Neil J. Houston, Jr. Residential Re-entry Center.</u>
- 4 The city of Pawtucket is authorized to exempt from taxation, to the extent the city council
- 5 of the city of Pawtucket may from time to time determine, the real and personal property of the
- 6 Neil J. Houston, Jr. Residential Re-entry Center located at 67-85 Slater Street, Pawtucket, RI.
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
