It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-9-11 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-9 entitled "Children" is 2 hereby repealed. 11-9-11. Designation of curfew streets. 3 4 The police commissioners of any city or town having a police commission, and the chief of police of any other city or town, may designate certain streets in the city or town as curfew 5 streets. No minor under sixteen (16) years of age shall be allowed to loiter on any curfew street 6 7 after 9 o'clock (9:00) p.m., unless accompanied by some adult person. 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
