4	"lights of her life" Dylan, Ethan, Lucy, Charlotte, and Collin Silva; and
5	WHEREAS, Jeanne Santos grew up in the Fox Point neighborhood of Providence, the
6	daughter of the late Angelo and Virginia Santos, and sister of Debra Santos and Pamela Cameron.
7	She attended Fox Point Elementary School and Nathan Bishop Junior High School, and was a
8	graduate of Hope High School. Upon graduating, she worked as an administrative assistant and
