It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 8-19 of the General Laws entitled "Language Interpreters - Use of
2 Language Interpreters in Legal Proceedings" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following
3 section:

4 **8-19-7. Confidential communications.**

5 No interpreter/transliterators appointed pursuant to this chapter to interpret or translate for
6 limited-English-proficient persons in proceedings before the state courts in Rhode Island shall be
7 called upon to testify concerning any statement(s) made to them in connection with the
8 interpreter's or transliterator's interpretation or transliteration without the consent of the person
9 making the statement or unless compelled by court order.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
