She earned her Bachelor of Arts degree in Psychology from Lake Forest College in Illinois, her 5 Associate's degree in Nursing from the Community College of Rhode Island, a Bachelor of 6 7 Science degree in Nursing from Rhode Island College, and a Master of Science Nursing degree in Clinical Practice from the University of Rhode Island.
