- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 30-15 of the General Laws entitled "Emergency Management" is

- 3 30-15-45. Essential mental health and substance use disorder services.
- 4 <u>During any declared state or local disaster emergency pursuant to this chapter, mental</u>
- 5 <u>health and substance use disorder services provided by Alcoholics Anonymous, Narcotics</u>
- 6 Anonymous or other agencies that provide similar services to those seeking support for substance
- 7 <u>use disorders shall be considered an essential health benefit and the services provided thereby shall</u>
- 8 <u>be permitted during the disaster emergency; provided, that adequate measures are implemented to</u>
- 9 provide the services safely within whatever guidelines may be established to address the issues
- 10 relative to the declared disaster emergency.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
