It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 25-2 of the General Laws entitled "Days of Special Observance" is
- 2 hereby amended by adding thereto the following section:
- 3 **25-2-60. First responders day.**
- 4 The seventeenth day of March shall annually be set aside as a day to be known as "Rhode
- 5 Island's First Responder Day". This nation and state owe an enormous debt to law enforcement
- 6 officers and fire service department professionals who work diligently and tirelessly to protect the
- 7 people and property in Rhode Island. They protect our schools, public meeting places, homes and
- 8 our physical safety twenty-four (24) hours a day, every day of the year. These devoted public
- 9 service employees always answer the call and always come to the aid of those in need, regardless
- 10 of the dangers they face or the possible consequences they may endure. This day shall be observed
- 11 by the people of the state with appropriate ceremonies and activities that celebrate the many
- 12 contributions of Rhode Island first responders.
- 13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
