It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Title 42 of the General Laws entitled "STATE AFFAIRS AND 2 GOVERNMENT" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following chapter: 3 CHAPTER 46.1 **AUDIO AND VIDEO RECORDINGS** 4 5 42-46.1-1. Recordings to be made. 6 (a) Every public body, as defined in § 42-46-2, of every state, city, town or regional district; 7 shall live stream to the Internet all open meetings, as defined in chapter 46 of this title; post the 8 video to its websites within twenty-four (24) hours of the meeting; and shall maintain a recording of said meeting for future viewing, and provide same to the office of the secretary of state. State 9 10 public bodies shall include public bodies in the executive branch of state government. 11 (b) This section shall not apply to public bodies whose responsibilities are solely advisory 12 in nature. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage. 13 LC001754
